Bill Sayer embarked on his Round Norfolk Walk, eventually walking 230 miles in 13 days and spending most nights camping out in the "wilds" of Norfolk.

On 4th March Bill headed south from where Pedders Way crosses the A47 at Swaffham and spent his first night in Thetford Forest. He

could hear Deer barking all around and woke in the morning to thick ice on puddles.

After two days Bill realised he would have to dump non—essentials (most warm clothes, over sleeping bag, some food and a water bottle) from his rucksack making it 15KG. Using Angles Way and following the River Waveney to Yarmouth he joined Weavers Way to Sea Palling where he had a rest day. He was joined here by Vicar, Simon Stokes and his lovely Guide Dog, Hope.

On to Blickling Hall with heavy rain and then the North Norfolk Coastal Path where Simon and Hope left Bill to carry on to Wells where he stayed overnight in a B&B, enjoying a hearty breakfast to give renewed energy, Continuing back onto Pedders Way he spent the last night in Castle Acre with just 6 miles to do on the last day.

Bill said everywhere people asked him what he was doing and spontaneously donated. He said we are so privileged to live in such a varied County, from the uplands of Pedders Way, forests of Thetford, the heaths and water meadows of the Broads, Cromer hills, cliffs and Salt Marshes all teaming with wildlife.

In the picture above Bill, Simon and Hope came to Tesco (permission was asked!) while Val & David were doing the 3-5pm slot of a store collection. Bill presented Val with a cheque for £550. This represented half of the money raised with the other half going to 45th Norwich Scout Group.

Thanks to Alan Hewett for arranging the presentation and to Robin & Wendy Cushing who stayed after doing the 1-3pm slot. It was a shame an EDP photographer was unable to attend, details and photos will be given to them so, keep an eye out.

Thank you Bill for thinking of the Norfolk Zipper Club (Papworth Hospital Charity), the money will be well spent to help patients from Norfolk & Suffolk. It must have been challenging at times but what an achievement.
